

RESOLUTION 20-17

A resolution of the County Board of Supervisors of Wayne County, Iowa, approving a new Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP) Fund 0030 for the Wayne County Conservation Board.

WHEREAS, the Wayne County Conservation Board has received restitution from a Wayne County Resident as ordered by the Iowa Department of Natural Resources.

WHEREAS, Iowa law requires counties to create a special supplemental environmental project (SEP) fund 0030 when receiving restitution.

WHEREAS, the funds may be carried over from year to year and all interest earned on funds shall be credited to that account and used as specified in 2001 agreement between the Iowa Department of Natural Resources and the Wayne County Conservation Board.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that the fund is necessary to meet the county's obligations of the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the County Board of Supervisors of Wayne County, Iowa, by way of this Resolution hereby approves the County Auditor to create a new Fund 0030 for Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP) for the Wayne County Conservation Board.

The above and foregoing resolution was adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Wayne County, Iowa, this 21st day of October 2019, and the vote thereon being unanimous.
